LIST OF WATERS 2008

The society has both still and running water venues in and around the East Grinstead area. Here is a brief description of where you can fish and what you can expect to catch.

LAKES

Bowens Farm

Ford Manor (1.5 acres in Surrey) – This small estate lake holds Carp to double figures, Rudd, Tench, Roach and Crucian Carp.

<u>Hedgecourt Lake</u> (43 acres in Surrey) – A large lake set in an area classified as a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI). Holds large stocks of good sized Bream, double figure Carp and Pike, Roach, Perch and Eels.

<u>Imberhorne Pond</u> (1 acre in West Sussex) – Stocked with lots of Carp to double figures, Crucian Carp, Perch and Roach. This pond is partly owned by the Society.

<u>Kidbrooke Lake</u> (3 acres in East Sussex) – Contains Carp, Tench, Roach, Rudd, Perch and is particularly noted for its large stock of Chub that provide great sport.

Readers Lake (3 acres in West Sussex) – Purposely designed and constructed by EGAS, this terrific water is stocked with Carp to double figures, Crucian Carp, Tench, Bream, Roach and Perch.

<u>Saint Hill Lake</u> (2 acres in West Sussex) – The Society has agreed conditional fishing rights on this lightly fished lake in the grounds of St Hill Manor, access may be restricted at certain times.

<u>Weir Wood reservoir</u> (280 acres in East Sussex)- Open all year - This reservoir has recently been opened for coarse fishing, Club members can fish for free (except matches), Contains large stocks of Carp 30lb+, Pike 30lb+, Bream 8lb+, Roach, Perch, Trout.

RIVERS

<u>Medway</u> (5.5 miles on Kent / Sussex borders) – A deeply cut stretch of scenic river with both deep and shallow runs. Good numbers of Chub with some larger specimens, noted for its Barbel to 14lbs, Roach, Bream, Pike, perch, Dace and Trout.

<u>Eden Brook</u> (2.5 mile tributary of River Eden in Surrey) – A narrow river holding Chub to 5lb+, Carp to 17lb+, Bream, Pike, Dace and Eels.

<u>Hedgecourt Feeder Stream</u> (1/2 mile in Surrey) – Situated in SSSI, noted for good sized pike (club record 25lbs+) and Roach, also Bream shoals.

Please Note

The Rivers and Hedgecourt lake and Feeder stream are closed by Law from March 15th to June 15th inclusive. The Society operates a closed season on all other waters from 15th March to 31st May inclusive. Weir Wood is open all year.
